Working in Conjunction with Other Services

Working with BHRS/WrapAround:

Many BHRS are not equipped or trained to work with young children with ASD. Transition to BHRS for school age children following 1:1 intensive behavior interventions at the Center can provide the continuation of services necessary for your child to be successful in school. GBS can provide training to BHRS staff as requested (contact GBS to inquire about fees and schedule)

Working with School Systems:

ABA is a prescribed service. Parents can choose to bring their child to the center 2 or 4 days a week for services, much like going to any other prescribed service.

ESY can involve related services. Parents are encouraged to talk to the school about having their child attend the Center as a related service under ESY in place of traditional ESY services.

GBS staff can provide training and in-service workshops to school districts. Have school administration contact GBS for fees and schedule.

Working with other Professionals:

GBS respects all other service professionals, including but not limited to OT's, PT's, SLP's, Vision Specialists, etc. Most often, behavioral goals from other service providers can be incorporated into GBS treatment plans for consistency and continuation of skills across services.

Working with Parents:

GBS provides 1:1 parent training on Fridays. Parents schedule with GBS staff and bring their child to the session. Parents are provided a 1:1 session and program review for generalization to the parent and carry over into the home.
