

Potential Disgnostic Evaluations: (in addition to ADMI/Geisinger)

- First meet with your primary care physician and do an Autism Screening Tool such as the MCHAT (also available online).
- Then call your insurance to find out what they need for a diagnostic evaluation for an autism diagnosis. Some insurances require specific tests to approve ABA services (for example, Tricare requires the ADOS).
- Then contact the evaluators listed below. Do they accept your insurance? Do they provide the evaluation tests your insurance requires?
- When the evaluation is complete, and if the diagnosis is Autism, request a recommendation of ABA. You can request the evaluator recommend “20hrs of ABA in a center based setting.... 15 hrs of ABA at school..... 10 hrs of ABA in the home... etc.”
- For the center, you will want up to 15 hrs of ABA in a center based program overseen by a BCBA with 2 hrs a month of parent training with client present.
- Continue to make appointments with Geisinger/Hershey/etc. Since these are often a year out, by the time you get in, it will be time for re-evaluation anyway!
